In 1998, Jose joined Kado Kyoju Kai, the original Ikebana teachers association in the Los Angeles area, and is a current member of that group, reorganized as Ikebana Teachers Association of Southern California. He has served many years as President of Ikebana International Los Angeles Chapter No. 4. He is currently president of Ikenobo Ikebana Los Angeles Society. Among his other activities, he teaches Urasenke Chado (tea ceremony).
